## **APPRENTICESHIP & TRAINING PROGRAM FOR ELECTRICIANS**

### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

AGE - Minimum age 18 EDUCATION - High School graduate or GED equivalent

#### **APPLICATIONS:**

You may apply only when the application process is open. Call (972) 550-1133 for further information. Our fax # is (972) 550-1121

#### **LENGTH OF APPRENTICESHIP:**

Normally it takes 4 years to complete the program of 8,000 hours of on the job training, 576 hours of classroom work with passing grades and passing the required state of Texas journeyman exam to receive your state electrical license.

**COST:** \$25.00 Application fee when you make application to the program (cash/credit card) \$50.00 Registration fee due at time of registration. (cash/credit card)

**TUITION** - your tuition is deducted from your pay each week by your employer and sent to IEC. Tuition is based on a cents per hour for each hour worked.

1 <sup>st</sup> Pd:	0 - 1000 hours OJT	37¢ per hour worked
2 <sup>nd</sup> Pd:	1001 - 2000 hours OJT	41¢ per hour worked
3 <sup>rd</sup> Pd:	2001 - 4000 hours OJT	49¢ per hour worked
4 <sup>th</sup> Pd:	4001 - 6000 hours OJT	56¢ per hour worked
5 <sup>th</sup> Pd:	6001 - 8000 hours OJT	64¢ per hour worked

#### **OTHER REQUIREMENTS:**

Social Security Card Valid Driver's License High School transcript and college transcript (if any) Diploma and/or GED scores DD 214 (if veteran) State of Texas Electrical Apprentice License Registered with Selective Service System (www.sss.gov) Evidence of previous experience in the electrical field (if any) Letter of Recommendation from a current or previous Employer Completion of Math Evaluation at I.E.C. Successful completion and passing a background check and drug screen

#### **TO BEGIN WORK:**

Applicant must first successfully pass a drug screen and background check when interview is complete, and you are accepted into the program.

After several weeks of employment with IEC contractor member, apprentice will be registered into the program with Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training, DOL.

Applicant must furnish his/her own tools.

Starting salary on the IEC wage scale is currently \$13.00 per hour.

#### **SPECIAL NOTE:**

Apprenticeship is open to all applicants who meet requirements without regard to race, creed, national origin or sex.
